MISSION STATEMENT:

The Pete Meadows Baseball Program (PMBP) was founded in 1987 as a for-profit sports training and player development program with an emphasis on Christian based leadership development for athletes ages 18-and-under. Since that time the PMBP has had over 30,000 personal exposures with athletes in the CSRA, and beyond.

In 2011, the decision was made to create a non-profit division allowing for a more pointed emphasis on meeting the needs of an ever growing segment in our community. With this decision, the PMBP joined forces with Visionary Ministries, LLC, an active International ministry with an emphasis on supporting the needs of Haitian Children and orphanages, to create a regional ministry beginning in December of 2011 .

This “ever growing segment” references at risk children and teenagers, ages 18-and-under, who do not typically fall under the categories that would meet requirements for government funding or grants. Our ministry seeks to fill the void.

We will work closely with area Youth Pastors, Coaches, Volunteers, and local and state based agencies in identifying these prospective participants. The baseline for entrance into the program begins with children coming from single, foster, and adoptive parent homes who are in need of the extra emotional and Christ based guidance and support. We additionally serve children of military families as well as children of fire and law enforcement services.

We provide a supplemental level of mentorship through Christ based leadership and influence by incorporating Christianity and baseball/softball together, to teach students positive values and leadership skills for life. We hope to engage participants through various training activities provided monthly from outside funding sources. These opportunities include private, small group sessions, and seasonal week long programs (Christmas, Masters Week, and Summer Camp).

Additional quarterly community service activity examples include leadership and service based programs such as cleaning yards for program adopted elderly individuals, delivering food at Thanksgiving, and delivering Christmas gifts and visiting MCG Children's hospital unit.

OUR PURPOSE:

We desire to fulfill the Great Commission through a practical real-life approach in meeting emotional and spiritual needs of the young people God provides us. And in the process we plant the seeds of leadership whose fruit will be Christ followers who will pass it forward in their future.

INDIVIDUAL LEVEL:

The Individual Level gift is for anyone choosing to “adopt” a single child through a month-to-month period by providing an ongoing monthly gift of \$75.*^

* = All gift donors will receive a personal bio and photo of the child they've sponsored, as well as quarterly reviews of how the child is progressing in all the areas of their lives. Donors can remain anonymous, but our program will require the participants to communicate with those who have supported them through a personal thank you on occasion.
